The key themes over the two days will provide delegates with a practical focus on how CH(C)Ps and their partners can support the improvement of health inequality outcomes in the key area of early years, the redesign of services, CH(C)Ps as advocates for community led health and resilience along with links to social enterprise and supporting employability and self management support.

There will of course also be a series of high profile speakers from the Scottish Government, (confirmation of the attendance of the Cabinet Minister is awaited) together with representatives from a wide range of organisations with interests in furthering the agendas and roles of CH(C)Ps. These will include the NHS in Scotland, Local Authorities, Voluntary Agencies and others.

There will be sessions and poster displays on practical applications and solutions. Abstracts for parallel sessions and posters in support of the key theme are very welcome. Details and forms attached.
